Alcoa, in cooperation with the Town of Louisville, plans to construct a recreational boating and fishing area located on the Grasse River for public use. The construction is part of a consent decree settlement between Alcoa and NOAA, DOI, NYSDEC and the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe who serve as Trustees for natural resources under the consent decree. A recreational fishing assessment performed jointly by Alcoa and the Trustees determined that Alcoa's construction of a recreational fishing area as depicted below will compensate the public for lost recreational fishing opportunities due to fish advisories posted in the area.

- Village of Louisville, adjacent to the Route 37 Bridge.
